Of course, on any and every day of the year, from Jan. 1 through Dec. 31, weather permitting, our nation's flag can be proudly displayed, but, for a handy reference as we begin 2014, the following is a listing of holidays, patriotic observances, and other specially designated days on which it is particularly appropriate to fly the Stars and Stripes.

Lincoln's Birthday - Feb. 12

Washington's Birthday - Feb. 22

President's Day - 3rd Mon. in Feb.

Easter Sunday

National Day of Prayer - 1st Thur. in May

Armed Forces Day - 3rd Sat. in May

Memorial Day (half-staff until noon)

Flag Day - June 14

Other days to fly the flag include Inauguration Day (Jan. 20 of the years in which this occurs); election days; statehood anniversaries, such as Feb. 14 in Arizona; state holidays; and "other days as may be proclaimed by the President of the United States".

The flag should always be displayed in a respectful manner, in accordance with the protocols of the official U.S. Flag Code. Numerous websites, such as www.vfw.org, www.vfw.org, www.usflag.org, and www.publications.usa.gov, offer more information about our American flag, its history, the U.S. Flag Code, and the proper display and care of our country's honored national emblem.






