Events to Remember in September

This month, Americanism focuses on 3 events or observances that take place in September, which promote education and patriotism.

Recognizing that education and literacy were issues dear to the hearts of Republican First Ladies Barbara Bush and Laura Bush, the NFRW, in 2002, began designating September each year as **NFRW Literacy Month**. The Federation's website link to its



education and literacy programs explains, "Possessing the ability to read and write is fundamental. It makes learning possible, inevitable and infinite... We ensure freedom for the next generation when we teach them to read and write, giving them the tools they need to develop political literacy."

The NFRW encourages local Republican Women's Clubs to take part in various literacy-promoting projects, such as its Mamie Eisenhower Library Project, throughout the year, but particularly during Literacy Month in September. Over the past several decades, Republican Women's Clubs have donated thousands of books from the MELP Suggested Reading List to schools, libraries and charitable organizations. MELP Reading List books are chosen to foster a love of reading and learning, to educate and inspire readers of all ages, while promoting patriotism and knowledge of America and its noteworthy history. A quote by 1st century Greek philosopher, Epictetus, is MELP's theme for this year: "*Only the Educated Are Free*". It was through education that Epictetus was able to secure his freedom from slavery. The connection between literacy/education and freedom is worth considering in light of a recent statistic from the National Institute of Literacy, estimating that at least 20% of graduating high school seniors in America are functionally illiterate.

For Arizona Republican Women's Clubs this year, the AzFRW has organized a **Literacy Month "Bucks for Books"** program, and is asking members of all our state chapters to consider making contributions toward the purchase of books from the MELP list for donation to recipients in their local communities (see separate article in our newsletter).

Events celebrating **Constitution Day** (Sept. 17) are another way of encouraging patriotism and educating Americans, by developing a deeper understanding of, and respect for, our U.S. Constitution. The annual Gilbert, AZ Constitution Week Fair is considered one of the largest in the country. This year's fair, scheduled for Sat., Sept. 20, 6–9:30 p.m., at the Gilbert Civic Center, will feature Lee Greenwood and a 350-voice choir, in addition to many patriotic displays, family-oriented activities and fireworks.

Also in Gilbert, as well as in Phoenix and Chandler, **Patriot Day** on Sept 11, can be observed with solemn reflection at the permanent memorials, established by each of these cities in remembrance of those who lost their lives when our country was attacked in 2001. Unlike the radically destructive ideology of the terrorists responsible for the 9/11 attacks, and of those who continue to threaten liberty, may America be dedicated to educating every citizen in the fundamental truths that our nation's considered "self-evident, that all men are created equal,...endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." It is essential that we promote education and literacy among all Americans, with attention to *what* is read and learned, in addition to ensuring a solid grounding in our Constitution and our foundational principles of freedom.


"Bucks for Books" National Federation of Republican Women Celebrates Literacy Month
